Step 1: Register at Swan Hill Library or on our outreach vehicle, 'Libby' and collect a BIG Summer Read reading log or starter pack

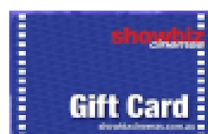
Step 2: Read 10 books or for 10 hours and return the completed reading log to receive a prize

Step 4: Join us for the major prize draw on Friday, 9 February 2024!

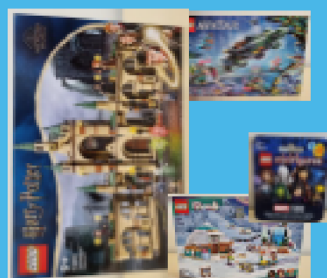
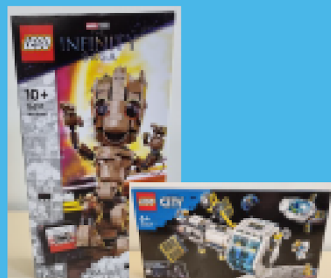
